Tips to help you #DethronetheLoan

Read the Eligibility Criteria Carefully: Every UNCF opportunity has unique requirements. Make sure you thoroughly review each one to ensure you're eligible before applying. Missing this step can waste time and effort.

Apply to Every Opportunity You Qualify For: With over 400 programs posted annually, don't limit yourself! If you meet the criteria, apply—you increase your chances of receiving financial aid by casting a wide net.

Complete Every Section of the Application: Even if some sections are optional, like awards or leadership experience, take the time to fill them out. These details can set you apart from other applicants.

Start Early and Stay Organized: Don't wait until the last minute. Keep track of deadlines, required documents, and essays so you can submit a polished, complete application.

Proofread and Review: Before submitting, double-check for errors and make sure you've attached everything needed, like transcripts or essays. A well-organized, error-free application reflects your attention to detail.

The **UNCF STEM Scholars Program** is an initiative designed to identify and provide scholarship and academic support for African American high school students who aspire to earn STEM degrees and to pursue careers in STEM fields, awarding 100 scholarships on an annual basis. The program enables highly capable young people to pursue undergraduate STEM majors and prepares them for successful careers in a variety of STEM professions.

Up to \$25,000

Eligibility Criteria

To qualify, applicants must:

- - Be African American, Hispanic American, Asian Pacific Islander American, American Indian / Alaskan Native
- - Be a citizen, legal permanent resident, or national of the United States
- - Have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 on an unweighted 4.0 scale
- - Pursued a rigorous course of study in high school in math and science courses, including pre-calculus
- - Have demonstrated financial and unmet need as measured by the student's college or university
- - Show evidence of readiness for and commitment to pursue STEM majors, including biological/life sciences, physics, chemistry, computer science/engineering, information sciences, engineering (industrial, mechanical, electrical or chemical), mathematics
- - Complete all of the application essays
- - Arrange for a letter of recommendation to be submitted via the UNCF application portal
- - Be enrolled for the first time at a U.S.-located, accredited college or university (with the exception of students concurrently pursuing a high school diploma while taking college-level courses) in the fall as a full-time, degree-seeking, first-year student

2025-2026 UNCF STEM Scholars Program

The **FUND II—UNCF STEM Scholars Program** application is open to incoming first-year college students.

The program awards **100 scholarships**, valued at up to **\$25,000**, to graduating high school seniors who aspire to pursue a STEM degree in college and a STEM career.

PROGRAM BENEFITS INCLUDE:

- Tiered tuition scholarships **up to \$25,000**: \$2,500—for freshmen and sophomore academic years, \$5,000—for juniors and seniors' academic years. An additional \$5,000 for eligible fifth-year students.
- A **\$5,000 internship & research stipend** for a STEM-related internship or project, paving the way for a successful career in STEM.
- Participation in STEM-focused Fall 2025 Institute (all expenses paid)
- **The program includes award-winning**, in-depth, academic, wrap-around support services, including no-cost online and virtual tutoring in all STEM-related subjects by college faculty, mentoring, exclusive pre-medical advising, internship and career coaching, mental health and wellness programming, and more.

- Have demonstrated financial and unmet need as measured by the student's college or university
- Show evidence of readiness for and commitment to pursue STEM majors, including biological/life sciences, physics, chemistry, computer science/engineering, information sciences, engineering (industrial, mechanical, electrical or chemical), mathematics
- Be planning to enroll for the first time at a U.S.-located, accredited college or university in Fall 2025

The **UNCF K-12 Education Fellowship** is a leadership and talent development initiative aimed at building a robust pipeline of high-achieving African Americans engaged in education in America. The program selects undergraduate juniors from historically black colleges and universities (HBCUs) to participate in a 10-week summer experience that includes leadership development, a paid internship with an innovative K-12 educational organization or school, and participation in an education reform case competition. Upon completion of the ten-week summer experience, Fellows have access to additional coaching and skills development aligned with K-12 career pathways during their senior year of college.

ELIGIBLE STUDENTS MUST:

- Have at least a 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale
- Must be a U.S. citizen or a permanent resident
- Must be enrolled at an HBCU and classified as a Third Year Student (Junior)
- Demonstrated leadership experience and community service while a college student
- Have an interest in K-12 education as evidenced by academic, paid or volunteer experience, and/or extra-curricular activities

- Complete the online application
- Submit a personal statement describing your interest in K-12 education
- Submit a current resume, updated as of Fall 2024
- Submit a recent transcript as of Fall 2024
- Submit a letter of recommendation from an administrator or faculty member at your current institution
