Medical Assistance

- Mecklenburg County Health Department can provide follow-up medical care, including free STD testing and free preventive medication for STDs, HIV, and pregnancy.
- Students can go to **Presbyterian or Carolinas Medical Hospital** for medical services.
- A Sexual Assault Exam is available at both local hospitals. The exam includes preventive treatment for sexually transmitted infections, pregnancy, and evidence collection. The exam is conducted by a Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) who is a Registered Nurse with advanced training and certification in conducting sexual assault exams.

Emergency Services

- **Campus Police** provides 24-hour emergency services
- Students can also call 911 for 24-hour emergency services from the Mecklenburg County Police Department.

Advocacy and Support Services

- **"I Matter"** provides information referrals, psychoeducation (healthy relationships, self-esteem and conflict resolution), advocacy, individual & group counseling, and support groups
- **Counseling Services** provides individual and group counseling and psychotherapy, crisis intervention and consultation.
- The **Campus Case Manager/Community Liaison** provides case management services to students to include being linked to community and campus resources to meet varying needs.
- The **Safe Alliance Rape Crisis & Domestic Violence Hotline** provides a crisis line, DV Shelter, 24-hour advocacy, counseling services and safety planning to include assisting with restraining orders.
- The **Women's Commission** provides counseling for victims of Dating/Domestic Violence.

Housing and Academic Accommodations

- The **Dean of Health and Wellness** can assist with academic and housing accommodation, referrals, and judicial matters.
- The **Office of Residence Life** can assist with housing accommodations.
