

**The Charlotte Incentive Grant-In-Aid
2013-2014
Johnson C. Smith University**

Purpose: To provide scholarship assistance to deserving students graduating from Charlotte-Mecklenburg area high schools and Central Piedmont Community College.

Award Amount: The student will receive a monetary amount of \$2,000 dollars per year for a period of four years (Freshman Only) or \$2,000 for two years for Central Piedmont Community College transfer students.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. The student must have graduated from a Charlotte-Mecklenburg high school and be a first time Freshman. ONLY transfers students from Central Piedmont Community College are eligible for this grant.

**Central Piedmont Community College prospects need not be graduates of a Charlotte-Mecklenburg high school. Central Piedmont graduates must have completed and been awarded an Associate Degree as a condition of eligibility.

2. Charlotte-Mecklenburg graduates must have minimum grade point average of 2.50 or better.
3. Students must demonstrate leadership and involvement in extracurricular activities in high school.
4. Students must have paid housing and matriculation for the fall semester at Johnson C. Smith University, and take at least twelve hours.
5. Student must maintain a minimum grade point average of 2.0
6. Prospective freshman students must reside on campus.
